## No Access - No Education - No Job... **No Hope**

- 50% of First Nations children in Canada live in poverty compared to 15% for non-Indigenous children.
- The unemployment rate of Indigenous people in Canada is double that of non-Indigenous people (15.0% Vs. 7.5%).
- More than 400,000 Indigenous youth in Canada are positioned to enter the labour market within the next decade and they need education and skills to contribute/succeed.
